

Information on data protection

With this data protection declaration the Institute Krems Bioanalytics, Technology & Research Center, Magnesitstrasse 1, A-3500 Krems, Austria (referred to hereinafter as "Institute Krems Bioanalytics") as part of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems, Piaristengasse 1, A-3500 Krems, Austria, provides information, in accordance with the applicable legal provisions, regarding what personal data is collected, processed and used as part of the use of the services provided (registrations, applications, studies etc.) and the website.

For data processing at the Institute Krems Bioanalytics, the following categories of data processors are used in addition to those mentioned separately in this declaration: IT service providers, providers of access control systems, service providers for accounting and controlling, and providers of data management systems.

1. Customers and suppliers data

The University of Applied Sciences Krems and the Institute Krems Bioanalytics process customers and suppliers data of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics Krems (as far as these are natural persons: first name, last name, title, address, country, telephone number, company, UID, e-mail address) on the basis of fulfilment of any existing contract (Art 6 para 1 lit b GDPR) or on the basis of consent given by transmission of the contact data (e.g. handover of a business card for further use) Art 6 para 1 lit a GDPR); this consent can be withdrawn at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on consent before its withdrawal (see also - "Withdrawal of given consent").

The data is processed primarily by employees of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics and the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems.

2. Marketing

Data transmitted to the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems on behalf of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics or directly to the Institute Krems Bioanalytics in the course of establishing contact (e.g. event participations, information request) are used for further marketing purposes (e.g. invitation to other events, Christmas cards etc) of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics. This processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics in accordance with Art 6 para 1 lit f GDPR, which ensures in an essential way the competitiveness of the institute and its existence in competition on the open market. There is no legal obligation to provide this data.

An objection (datenschutz@imc.ac.at) against data processing for the purpose of direct marketing can be raised at any time in accordance with Art 21 para 2 GDPR, which entails the deletion of the named data. Use of the data will only take place to the extent necessary and in a comprehensible manner for the purpose of the enterprise and in compliance with appropriate technical and organisational security measures to protect the data.

3. Access Control System

For the purpose of managing and controlling the access rights to the buildings (main and auxiliary buildings, garages), the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems on behalf of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics processes the following data on the basis of the fulfilment of the shareholder agreement and the legitimate interest and as an expression of a technical-organizational security measure according to Art 6 para 1 lit b, c and f GDPR: first name, surname, title, gender, telephone/mobile number, email, communication language, personal/matriculation number, department, unit, number of movements, creation/modification date authorization, date/time last movement last used access, date/time rejected access, last denied access location, approved license plate number, activation during holidays, ID feature, approved premises, duration of approved premises and access groups, authorized entrances, date and duration of authorized entrances, event type (eg "authorized ID"), from event b detected access, log type (eg "event"), event timezone, event/move query date, event/move time, event/move server time, source (event location e.g. parking garage west), details (e.g., campus, "entry/exit").

There is no statutory obligation to provide this data, however, the non-provision of the information described precludes the conclusion of a contractual relationship with the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems on behalf of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics. The data is processed primarily by employees of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems and the Institute Krems Bioanalytics and stored for a period of 7 years (employees) from the company's exit. In addition, this data is transferred to providers of facility management services, access control systems, and IT services, which are used as data processors by the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems on behalf of the Institute Krems Bioanalytics in accordance with Art 28 GDPR.

4. Use of Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google", Google Ireland Ltd Gordon House, Barrow Street, Dublin 4, Ireland) for the purpose of customisation. Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies", text files that are stored on your computer and that allow an analysis of the use of the website by you.

The information generated by the cookies about your use of this website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. We only use Google Analytics with activated IP anonymisation. This means that the users IP addresses will be shortened by Google within member states of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be sent to a Google server in the US and shortened there. The IP address

submitted by the user's browser will not be merged with other data from Google. Google uses this information to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports on website activity for website operators, and to provide other services related to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties if required by law or as far as third parties process this data on behalf of Google. You may prevent the collection by Google of the data generated by the cookie and related to your use of the website as well as the processing of this data by Google by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available under the following link: <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=de>. However, please be aware that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website.

The use of cookies requires your consent given through this website. Your consent may be withdrawn at any time with future effect (see point "Withdrawal of given consent") without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on consent before its withdrawal. The storage of cookies can also be prevented by changing the settings of your browser software accordingly. Please be aware that the use of this website without the authorisation of cookies is not possible to the fullest extent.

5. Withdrawal of given consent

Any consent given may be withdrawn at any time (datenschutz@imc.ac.at) without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. In case of withdrawal of consent, all data traceable to your person will be deleted, and no further processing of your data will be carried out, insofar as this data was not processed before the time of the withdrawal in the event of subsequent withdrawal.

6. Rights of data subjects

You have the following rights:

- Right of access to the personal data concerned (Art 15 GDPR),
- Right to rectification (Art 16 GDPR) or erasure (Art 17 GDPR) or to restriction of processing (Art 18 GDPR) under the conditions described in the mentioned legal provisions
- Right to data portability (Art 20 GDPR), if the data processing is based on consent or fulfilment of a contract and is carried out by automated means – where technically feasible
- Right to object to the processing of data on grounds relating to his or her particular situation (Art 21 para 1 GDPR eg video/audio/image files) and to object to the processing of data for direct marketing purposes without any reason (Art 21 para 2 GDPR).
